Recording for the album began on days off in between touring My Volcano. After piecing together brand new songs and older ideas a cohesive shape started to form.

Guest vocals on SUN appear courtesy of the band's dear friend Alyx Dennison from Kyu who lends a gentle flowing easy vibe on a few of the tracks.

Most of the album was recorded in Richard's back room in Annandale Sydney but was finished in his new Blue Mountains home. The city, the mountains and of course the sun float up as some of the meandering themes on the album.

After being relatively quickly recorded and put together the recordings were then sent on to Brent Griffin for mixing. Brent found himself mixing and completing the album in New York.

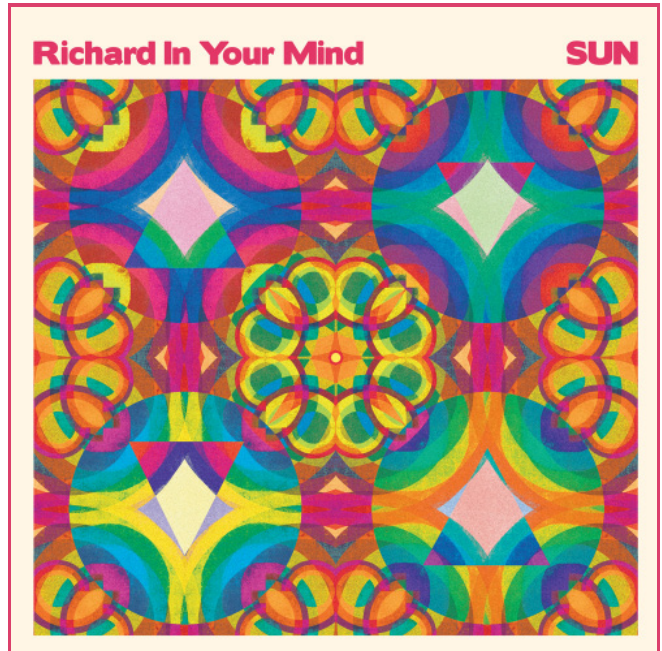
"We have always written about the sun," says Richard Cartwright.
